This will involve working with the County Board to achieve the "ClubMark" accreditation and ensuring that we have the necessary procedures and policy in place for our Junior members to play cricket in a safe and caring environment. As part of this process we are appointing a Club Welfare Officer who will act as the point of contact for any person with concerns about child welfare and protection within the Club. The Club is committed to ensuring that we act in accordance with the ECB and BCB guidelines to ensure the safety of all Juniors within the Club.

We are pleased to advise that Catherine Gold has agreed to become Club Welfare Officer at Winslow. Many of you may be aware that Catherine was involved for many years with Preston Gawcott Junior Football Club as Secretary. Catherine can be contacted on 01296 714683 if required.

All of our Team Managers are qualified ECB coaches and during the winter months have taken refresher courses in First Aid in Sport and also Good Practice and Child Protection. In accordance with ECB requirements, CRB checks are also undertaken.
